SENATE BILL 569

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the state Medicaid program; directing Oklahoma Health Care Authority to submit certain State Plan amendment; requiring inclusion of certain services; authorizing promulgation of rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5028.2 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall submit a Medicaid State Plan amendment to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services to permit schools to seek reimbursement for Medicaid 1905(a) services delivered in a school setting without the requirement for an individualized education plan (IEP).

B. Services included in the State Plan amendment shall include:

1. Nursing;
2. Behavioral health;
3. Speech therapy;

1 4. Occupational therapy; and

2 5. Physical therapy.

3 C. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board may promulgate  
4 rules as necessary to provide for the implementation of this  
5 section.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
