6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to professions and occupations;
8 amending 59 O.S. 2021, Sections 536.8 and 3040.13,
9 which relate to registration; removing requirement
10 for license registration to a county clerk; repealing
11 59 O.S. 2021, Section 510, which relates to
12 registration of corporations; and providing an
13 effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 536.8, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 536.8. ~~A. Every person who is licensed pursuant to the~~
18 ~~provisions of the Registered Electrologist Act and who is licensed~~
19 ~~to practice electrolysis in this state shall register the license~~
20 ~~with the county clerk of the county in which said person has legal~~
21 ~~residence. The county clerk to whom such license is presented shall~~
22 ~~register the name and address of the person designated in the~~
23 ~~license, together with the date and the number inscribed thereon,~~
24 ~~which record shall be open to the public, and shall file with the~~

1 ~~Board annually, during the month of February, a notice of the record~~
2 ~~so made.~~

3 ~~B.~~ Every person who is licensed pursuant to the provisions of
4 the Registered Electrologist Act to practice electrolysis in this
5 state shall keep said license displayed in his place of business as
6 long as he is engaged in the practice of electrolysis. The receipt
7 for the annual renewal of license shall be kept at such person's
8 place of business and shall be shown to any person requesting to see
9 the same. The licensee shall keep the Board informed of his current
10 address. A license issued by the Board is the property of the Board
11 and shall be surrendered on demand of the Board.

12 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 3040.13, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 3040.13. A. The State Department of Health shall
15 maintain a roster of each person licensed as a midwife in this
16 state. The roster shall contain for each licensed midwife the
17 information required on the informed choice and disclosure statement
18 under Section 3040.10 of this title and other information the
19 Department determines necessary to accurately identify each licensed
20 midwife. The roster shall be a public document available under the
21 Oklahoma Open Records Act.

22 B. The Department shall provide ~~each county clerk and~~ each
23 local registrar of births in a county with the name of each midwife
24 practicing in the county.

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C. Any data required to be submitted to the Department pursuant to Shepherd's Law shall not contain any personally identifying information of the client by the midwife and shall be considered confidential records collected for statistical information purposes only.

SECTION 3. REPEALER 59 O.S. 2021, Section 510, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.

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
