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SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-712.2 of Title 63, unless
 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
 A. A hospital, medical facility, or long-term care facility

8 B. Any person shall have the right to obtain, upon request, 9 detailed information of all additions, deletions, and other edits to 10 his or her medical records made by a hospital, medical facility, or 11 long-term care facility, or those of:

12 1. A minor child of whom the person is the parent or legal 13 guardian; or

14 2. Any other patient who lacks capacity to make medical 15 decisions and for whom the person has legal authority to make such 16 decisions and would have legal access to the patient's medical 17 records.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
