SENATE BILL 938 By: Jett

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; creating the Time Release Educational Credit Act (TRECA); providing short title; defining term; allowing a school district board of education to implement certain policy; providing criteria for participation in certain released time; requiring promulgation of rules that include certain provisions; providing for attendance of certain students; providing for transportation; prohibiting certain participation in lieu of participation in certain course of instruction; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

- SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-103.6p of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Time Release Educational Credit Act" (TRECA).
- B. As used in this act, "released time" means a period of time during a school day when a student is allowed to participate in an elective course in religious instruction conducted by a private entity off school district property.

- C. A school district board of education may implement a policy allowing a student to attend released time as an elective course if the following criteria are met:
- 1. The parent or legal guardian of the student provides written consent;
- 2. The religious curriculum of the elective course does not undeniably promote licentiousness or practices that are inconsistent with the peace and safety of this state;
- 3. The private entity conducting the religious instruction makes provisions for and assumes liability for the student during released time;
- 4. No public funds shall be expended to provide released time;
- 5. No school district personnel are involved in providing religious instruction.
- D. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this act including rules providing for elective course credit to be granted to a student who participates in released time pursuant to the provisions of this act and minimum standards for attendance necessary to qualify for the elective course credit. Elective course credit granted pursuant to this subsection shall not exceed credit given for any other elective course offered by a school district.

- E. A student who participates in released time pursuant to this act shall be considered in attendance while participating in religious instruction.
- F. Transportation to and from the released time location shall be provided by the private entity providing religious instruction off school district property, the parent or legal guardian of the participating student, or the participating student.
- G. A student shall not be permitted to participate in released time in lieu of participation in a course of instruction, the subject of which is included on assessments administered pursuant to Section 1210.508 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
  - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
