SENATE BILL 955

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to dictatorial officials; creating certain felonies; requiring certain registering; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2110 of Title 21, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. It shall be a felony for any member of the Communist Party of China (CPC) or any person who has ever held employment as an official or authority within the government of the People's Republic of China (PRC) to own any property within this state.

B. It shall be a felony for any member of the Communist Party of China (CPC) or any person who has ever held employment as an official or authority within the government of the People's Republic of China (PRC) to harass, intimidate, or threaten any citizen of this state.

1 C. Any member of the Communist Party of China (CPC) or any
2 person who has ever held employment as an official or authority
3 within the government of the People's Republic of China (PRC) shall
4 register with the Governor, Secretary of State, President Pro
5 Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House of Representatives, and
6 all members of the congressional delegation of this state before
7 entering this state in writing.

8 D. The provisions of subsections A, B, and C of this act shall
9 apply to any person who has ever held employment as an official or
10 authority within the government of any country currently categorized
11 as being a dictatorship or as being communist according to the
12 United States State Department or the United States Central
13 Intelligence Agency.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
