8 AS INTRODUCED

9 A Concurrent Resolution recognizing March 6 as Bob
10 Wills Day at the Capitol; celebrating the life and
11 legacy of Oklahoma's son; thanking the Oklahoma
Historical Society and the Oklahoma Arts Council for
their work; and directing distribution.

13 WHEREAS, Bob Wills, born in 1905, began playing fiddle in his
14 youth before moving with his band, the Texas Playboys, to Oklahoma
15 in 1934 to pursue business and creative opportunities; and

16 WHEREAS, Bob Wills became known as the King of Western Swing as
17 he helped originate and popularize a unique genre of music rooted in
18 folk, jazz, and blues that would lead to the development of rock and
19 roll and modern country music; and

20 WHEREAS, Bob Wills entertained millions of people during his
21 heyday, performing twice weekly at what would become the historic
22 Cain's Ballroom in Tulsa, playing live daily radio broadcasts,
23 touring across the country, and appearing in more than a dozen
24 movies; and

1 WHEREAS, Bob Wills was inducted into the Country Music Hall of
2 Fame in 1968 and the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 1999, and was
3 named one of the 40 Greatest Men of Country Music by Country Music
4 Television; and

5 WHEREAS, Bob Wills' family has contributed his archival and
6 artifacts collection to the Oklahoma Historical Society to be
7 featured for future generations across from Cain's Ballroom at the
8 forthcoming OKPOP Museum; and

9 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Arts Council and Oklahoma Historical
10 Society have partnered to revive the tradition of Bob Wills Day at
11 the Capitol, celebrating one of Oklahoma's most significant figures
12 in the history of popular music who continues shining a bright light
13 on our state.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION
15 OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
16 CONCURRING THEREIN:

17 THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature recognizes March 6 as Bob
18 Wills Day at the Capitol.

19 THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature celebrates the life and
20 legacy of Oklahoma's son, Bob Wills.

21 THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature thanks the Oklahoma
22 Historical Society and the Oklahoma Arts Council for their work to
23 honor Bob Wills and revive this special celebration at the Capitol.
