11	WHEREAS, April 10, 2023, will mark the 25th anniversary of the
12	Good Friday Agreement, which is historic progress and a considerable
13	success despite outstanding issues in Northern Ireland; and
14	WHEREAS, there are Irish people alive today because of
15	continuous bipartisan support for the Good Friday Agreement by state
16	legislators, United States presidents, the U.S. Senate, U.S. House
17	of Representatives, and elected officials through partnerships with
18	the governments of the United Kingdom and Ireland; and
19	WHEREAS, we honor and give thanks for the Good Friday Agreement,
20	the framework for lasting peace in Northern Ireland, on the historic
21	anniversary of its ratification; and
22	WHEREAS, the Good Friday Agreement represented a landmark
23	breakthrough that provided Ireland with a political framework to
24 47	address its future and pursue its goals of remaining part of the

¹ U.K. or of Irish unity, and acknowledged the right of differing ² political traditions; and

WHEREAS, the Good Friday Agreement and subsequent agreements demonstrated democratic and peaceful resolution of differences. We recognize the British and Irish governments' ongoing support and implementation of this agreement. It is the irrevocable foundation of the peace process regardless of the U.K.'s status regarding the European Union; and

9 WHEREAS, members of both political parties in the U.S. came 10 together to support the Good Friday Agreement; and

WHEREAS, March 17 marks the annual celebration of the feast of Saint Patrick, the patron saint of Ireland. Irish Americans join with people of all ethnic origins for this celebration; and WHEREAS, 2023 also marks the 175th anniversary of the first flying of the Irish flag by Thomas F. Meagher, who embodied the links between Ireland and the U.S.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION
OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate celebrates the flag of Ireland as a symbol of the link between the U.S. and Ireland and celebrates it as a symbol of peace, and also celebrates St. Patrick's Day and the 22 25th anniversary of the Good Friday Agreement.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to Oklahoma's Congressional delegation, and it is requested they inform themselves
