NEW LAW 20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-195.3 of Title 70, unless 21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 22 A. An individual employed for the first time in the state as a 23 district superintendent shall complete the professional development 24 requirements provided for in subsection B of this section within the

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- first year of employment as a district superintendent to maintain a
 provisional or standard school superintendent certification. If the
 individual fails to complete the professional development
 requirements as provided for in this section, the individual's
 superintendent certification shall be considered invalid and the
 Oklahoma State Board of Education shall revoke the individual's
- B. During an individual's first year of employment as a superintendent, the individual shall attend professional development workshops or training seminars equal to sixty-six (66) hours of training in areas that include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - 1. Superintendent and board of education relationships;
 - 2. Legal issues, school law, and the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act;
 - 3. Staff relationships;

- 4. Community relationships;
 - 5. School finance;

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- 6. Plant management and school facilities;
- 7. Setting school district and site goals; and
- 20 8. Individuals with Disabilities Education Act.
- C. The professional development workshops or training seminars
 for a first-year superintendent shall be determined by the local
 school district based on the training areas and hours identified in
 subsection B of this section. The local school district shall issue

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a certificate to the superintendent upon completion of the
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    professional development requirements. Verification of completion
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    of the professional development requirements provided for in this
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    section shall be submitted to the Oklahoma State Department of
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    Education.
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        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.
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        SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
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    of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
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    declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
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    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
