L5	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

L8	A. As used in this section, "agency" means any agency, board,

C. Only official flags recognized by federal or state
government entities may be displayed by an agency on state property
or grounds.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
