3. Taking any of the above actions without giving prior notice
to the teacher's <u>or support employee's</u> supervisor or anyone else in
the teacher's relevant chain of command.

9 C. For the purposes of this section, "reporting" means 10 providing a spoken or written account to a supervising teacher, 11 administrator, school board member, representative from the State 12 Department of Education, law enforcement official, district 13 attorney, and/or parent or legal guardian of a student directly 14 impacted by the actions.

D. Each school district shall prominently post or publish a copy of this section of law in locations where it can reasonably be expected to come to the attention of all teachers <u>and support</u> employees.

E. Nothing in this section shall be construed to allow a teacher <u>or support employee</u> to violate students' or parents' rights to confidentiality and protection under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act <u>of 1974</u> (FERPA).
