8 PROPOSED POLICY COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

9 An Act relating to state contract employees;  
10 directing state agencies report number of contract  
11 employees; requiring reports to include pay;  
12 directing for reports to be made through existing  
13 software; granting the Office of Management and  
14 Enterprise Services certain rulemaking authority;  
15 providing for codification; and providing an  
16 effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 61.9 of Title 74, unless there  
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 A. All state agencies shall report to the Office of Management  
22 and Enterprise Services the number of contract employees within its  
23 agency.

24 B. Reports shall include the pay of each contract employee.

C. Reporting shall be made through existing payroll software,  
including, but not limited to, Workday VNDLY.

1 D. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall have  
2 the authority to promulgate rules to carry out the provisions of  
3 this act.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
