- d. if the expenditure is a payment to an employee, the employee's job title or other information that identifies their role within the organization.
- The ability to search or browse all individual expenditures 2. in each fiscal year;
- The ability to aggregate data and where appropriate, through interactive software, generate totals, averages, and other summary statistics broken down by year, Submitting Party, spending categories described in paragraph 1 of this section and other criteria that may be useful to the public;
- The ability to easily download all or a subset of expenditure data in a format that is widely usable and useful to members of the public; and
- The ability to browse and search anonymized annual salary and benefit information for all employees of the Submitting Party. A new section of law to be codified SECTION 5. NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 8205 of Title 62, unless there

Req. No. 13107 Page 3 A. The Submitting Party shall assist in the development, establishment, operation, storage, hosting, and support of the database. The Submitting Party shall submit data to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services in a manner and on a schedule prescribed by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

- B. Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit the Office of Management and Enterprise Services from including any information in the database that is not required to be included under this section and that is available to the public.
- C. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall enter into an annual agreement with other appropriate agencies to define data storage, privacy and security, data handling, user interface requirements, and other provisions considered necessary to ensure the proper maintenance and operation of the database.
- D. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall ensure that the database does not include any confidential information, information that is not eligible for release under the Oklahoma Open Records Act, or the names, Social Security numbers, or any other personally identifiable information about employees of Submitting Parties or other individuals.
- E. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall, on an ongoing basis, develop standardized reporting procedures and methodologies and may develop secure application programming interfaces so that data can be reported with minimal administrative

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    burden on the Office of Management and Enterprise Services, the
