L8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:				
L 9	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified				
20	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 690.11 of Title 63, unless there				
21	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:				
22	A. There is hereby created the Grants for Recovering,				
23	Improving, and Thriving economies program (GRIT). This program				
24	shall be administered by the Oklahoma Department of Emergency				

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Management. This program shall be for political subdivisions, with populations less than six thousand (6000) people who are directly impacted by events attributing to a Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) declared emergency or disasters. These political subdivisions may apply for a GRIT grant if they are unable to provide the full local match required under the relevant FEMA recovery program. The Department shall promulgate rules to administer the grant program.

SECTION 2. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management to be designated the "Grants for Recovering, Improving, and Thriving Economies Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the Department from appropriations. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Department for the purpose of Grants for Recovering, Improving, and Thriving economies program described in Section 1 of this act. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.

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
