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9 PROPOSED POLICY COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to emergency management; creating the
11 Grants for Recovering, Improving, and Thriving
12 economies program (GRIT); limiting populations able
13 to apply for grants; providing for administration by
14 the Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management;
15 authorizing the promulgation of rules; creating the
16 Grants for Recovering, Improving, and Thriving
17 Economies Revolving Fund; establishing revolving fund
18 characteristics; declaring funds appropriated;
19 providing for codification; and providing an
20 effective date.

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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

24 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 690.11 of Title 63, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. There is hereby created the Grants for Recovering,
Improving, and Thriving economies program (GRIT). This program
shall be administered by the Oklahoma Department of Emergency

1 Management. This program shall be for political subdivisions, with
2 populations less than six thousand (6000) people who are directly
3 impacted by events attributing to a Federal Emergency Management
4 Agency (FEMA) declared emergency or disasters. These political
5 subdivisions may apply for a GRIT grant if they are unable to
6 provide the full local match required under the relevant FEMA
7 recovery program. The Department shall promulgate rules to
8 administer the grant program.

9 SECTION 2. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a
10 revolving fund for the Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management
11 to be designated the "Grants for Recovering, Improving, and Thriving
12 Economies Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not
13 subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies
14 received by the Department from appropriations. All monies accruing
15 to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be
16 budgeted and expended by the Department for the purpose of Grants
17 for Recovering, Improving, and Thriving economies program described
18 in Section 1 of this act. Expenditures from said fund shall be made
19 upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as
20 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and
21 Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

22 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
