 - B. A possessory lien arising pursuant to Section 962 of this title shall be considered satisfied when the total amount of the debt for services rendered for wrecker or towing service of a combination vehicle is paid in full.
 - C. For the purposes of this section, a combination vehicle shall consist of a truck-tractor semitrailer combination with one or more attached trailers.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
