15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified			
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-107.5 of Title 63, unless			
17	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:			
18	There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund			
19	for the State Department of Health to be designated the "Community			
20	Health Center Access to Care Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a			
21	continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall			
22	consist of all monies directed for deposit to the fund by law. All			
23	monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated			
24	and may be budgeted and expended by the Department for the purpose			

of increasing access to care provided by community health centers authorized by the Public Health Service Act, 42 U.S.C., Section 330. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.
SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
