8 An Act relating to public health and safety; creating
9 the Community Health Center Access to Care Revolving
10 Fund; establishing the fund at the State Department
11 of Health; establishing revolving fund
12 characteristics; deeming funds appropriated;
13 requiring and limiting certain budgeting,
14 expenditures, and procedures; providing for
15 codification; providing an effective date; and
16 declaring an emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-107.5 of Title 63, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
22 for the State Department of Health to be designated the "Community
23 Health Center Access to Care Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a
24 continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall
consist of all monies directed for deposit to the fund by law. All
monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated
and may be budgeted and expended by the Department for the purpose

1 of increasing access to care provided by community health centers
2 authorized by the Public Health Service Act, 42 U.S.C., Section 330.
3 Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by
4 the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with
5 the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
6 approval and payment.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

8 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
