9 An Act relating to public health and safety; creating  
10 the Community Health Center Access to Care Revolving  
11 Fund; establishing the fund at the State Department  
12 of Health; establishing revolving fund  
13 characteristics; deeming funds appropriated;  
14 requiring and limiting certain budgeting,  
15 expenditures, and procedures; providing for  
16 codification; providing an effective date; and  
17 declaring an emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-107.5 of Title 63, unless  
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund  
23 for the State Department of Health to be designated the "Community  
24 Health Center Access to Care Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a  
continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall  
consist of all monies directed for deposit to the fund by law. All

1 monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated  
2 and may be budgeted and expended by the Department for the purpose  
3 of increasing access to care provided by community health centers  
4 authorized by the Public Health Service Act, 42 U.S.C., Section 330.  
5 Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by  
6 the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with  
7 the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for  
8 approval and payment.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

10 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
11 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
