PROPOSED POLICY COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE											
An Act relating to revenue and taxation; prescribing method to establish fair cash value of certain											
commercial structures; specifying assessment years											
for which valuation standard applicable; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.											
BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:											
SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified											
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2802.1A of Title 68, unless											
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:											
A. For the 2026 assessment year and each assessment year											
thereafter, with respect to any commercial buildings constructed											
without final interior elements such as finished ceilings, finished											
floors, interior walls, lighting fixtures, cabinetry work, and											
similar features, if the owner of the real property upon which the											
commercial buildings are constructed or the contractor responsible											

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for the construction of the commercial building intends to either

sell or lease to another person or entity in a manner that allows the tenant or new owner to finish out the interior of the commercial building, the county assessor shall establish the fair cash value of such properties using the method prescribed by subsection B of this section.

B. With respect to the commercial properties described by subsection A of this section, the county assessor shall not establish the fair cash value of the commercial building at a value which is in excess of the direct cost of the materials used to construct the commercial building prior to the installation or furnishing of the interior of the commercial building.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2026.

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
