- 1. Shall not be located within five hundred (500) feet of an occupied structure or occupied residence unless waived in writing by the owner of the structure or residence;
- 2. Shall not be located within fifty (50) feet of any outer boundary of the facility property;
- 3. Shall not be located within one hundred (100) feet from the centerline of any public road; and
- 4. Shall not be located within a half (1/2) mile from any public school or hospital.
- B. This act shall apply to 10 megawatt and larger solar energy and industrial battery storage facilities. Furthermore, this act shall apply to any project in development that does not yet have a power purchase agreement in place on or after the effective date of this act.
- SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
