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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2021, Section 2-
16	503.1j, is amended to read as follows:
17	Section 2-503.1j. A. Any licensee of a money
18	transmission, transmitter or wire transmitter business
19	pursuant to the Oklahoma Financial Transaction Reporting Act
20	and their delegates shall collect a fee of <del>Five Dollars</del>
21	<del>(\$5.00)</del> <u>Ten Dollars (\$10.00)</u> for each transaction not in
22	excess of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) and in addition to
23	such fee an amount equal to <del>one percent (1%)</del> <u>two percent (2%)</u>
24	of the amount in excess of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

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B. The fee prescribed by subsection A of this section shall be remitted quarterly to the Oklahoma Tax Commission on such forms as the Commission, with the assistance of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control, may prescribe for such purpose. All required forms and remittances shall be filed with the Tax Commission not later than the fifteenth day of the month following the close of each calendar quarter.

8 C. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall apportion all revenues
9 derived from the fee to the Drug Money Laundering and Wire
10 Transmitter Revolving Fund.

11 Every licensee and their delegates shall post a notice on a D. 12 form prescribed by the Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of 13 Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control that notifies customers that 14 upon filing an individual income tax return with either a valid 15 social security Social Security number or a valid taxpayer 16 identification number the customer shall be entitled to an income 17 tax credit equal to the amount of the fee paid by the customer for 18 the transaction.

E. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be afforded all provisions currently under law to enforce the provisions of subsection B of this section. If a licensee fails to file reports or fails to remit the fee authorized by subsection B of this section, the Oklahoma Tax Commission shall have the authority pursuant to Section 212 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes to suspend the license of the licensee

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and its delegates. A notification of the suspension shall also be sent to the State Banking Commissioner and the Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control. The licensee and its delegates may not reapply for a license until all required reports have been filed and all required fee amounts have been remitted.

F. Upon request from the Oklahoma Tax Commission, the State
Banking Commissioner may make a claim against the surety bond of the
licensee on behalf of the State of Oklahoma.

10 G. The Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs 11 Control and its attorneys may assist the Oklahoma Tax Commission in 12 conducting audits and the prosecution and/or or seeking of legal 13 remedies to ensure compliance with this act.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
