L 6	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified								
L7	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-189.3 of Title 70, unless								
L8	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:								
L 9	A. For this section, "special education administrator" means

22	B. Beginning July 1, 2025, no school district shall employ a

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1. Holds a valid standard teaching certificate issued by the State Board of Education; and

- 2. Except as provided for in subsection D of this section, obtains an acknowledgment of competency within one (1) year of being employed as a special education administrator.
- C. The State Board of Education shall issue an acknowledgement of competency in the area of mild-moderate disabilities, severe-profound disabilities, or comprehensive special education to a special education administrator who has:
- 1. Satisfactorily completed a one-hundred-fifty-clock-hour special education program prescribed by the State Board of Education which shall include training on the rules and regulations for the Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA); and
- 2. Achieved at least a seventy percent (70%) on a competency examination in the area of mild-moderate disabilities, severe-profound disabilities, or comprehensive special education administered by the State Department of Education.
- D. An individual who has a valid Special Education Teaching Certificate as provided for in Sections 6-122.7, 6-122.8, or 6-122.9 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall not be required to obtain an acknowledgement of competency.
- 22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

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declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
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    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
