8 PROPOSED OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

9 An Act relating to professions and occupations;  
10 modifying the Oklahoma Administrative Code; modifying  
11 requirements for funeral establishment vendor payment  
12 rules; providing for codification; and providing an  
13 effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 397 of Title 59, unless there is  
17 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 This section shall modify the Oklahoma Administrative Code  
19 Section 235:10-11-1 by the following provisions:

20 1. Penalties for vendor payments may only be imposed after a  
21 formal court judgment;

22 2. Penalties may only be imposed on funeral establishments and  
23 may not be imposed against the Funeral Director in Charge;

1       3. These rules are only applicable to active funeral  
2 establishments;

3       4. All funeral establishments must be in compliance with  
4 federal bankruptcy laws;

5       5. All cash payments made in advance must meet the requirements  
6 of consumer fund receipts.

7       SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
