15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 901.62 of Title 19, unless there
18	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	Training for rural firefighters shall be directed solely by the
20	Rural Fire Coordinators. Nothing in this section shall be construed
21	to prevent joint training between the Rural Fire Coordinators and
22	other entities.

1	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 325.5 of Title 74, unless there
3	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
4	No volunteer firefighters or rural firefighters shall be
5	required to attend any mandatory training not offered within their
6	district or county.
7	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
