7 POLICY COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

8 An Act relating to daylight saving time; creating the
9 Wyman West Actual Lock the Clock Act; amending
10 Section 1, Chapter 161, O.S.L. 2024 (25 O.S. Supp.
11 2024, Section 90.29), which relates to daylight
12 saving standard; mandating year-round standard time;
13 providing for noncodification; and providing an
14 effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
17 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

18 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Wyman West
19 Actual Lock the Clock Act".

20 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 161, O.S.L.
21 2024 (25 O.S. Supp. 2024, Section 90.29), is amended to read as
22 follows:

23 Section 90.29. ~~A. If a federal law is passed that authorizes~~
24 ~~states to observe daylight saving time year-round,~~ Upon returning
to Standard Time on November 2, 2025, this state shall adopt

1 ~~daylight saving~~ standard time as the year-round standard of time for
2 the entire state and all its political subdivisions.

3 ~~B. This section shall not be construed to affect the standard~~
4 ~~time established by federal law governing the movement of common~~
5 ~~carriers engaged in interstate commerce or the time for performance~~
6 ~~of an act by an officer or department of the United States, as~~
7 ~~established by a statute, lawful order, rule, or regulation of the~~
8 ~~United States or an agency thereof.~~

9 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
