14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 28-104 of Title 70, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	Private schools accredited by the State Board of Education or
19	another accrediting association shall not, as a condition of
20	acceptance, enrollment, or application, require that a student's
21	parent or guardian participate in the Oklahoma Parental Choice Tax
22	Credit Program created in Section 28-101 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma
23	Statutes.
24	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval. 60-1-13204 AQH 03/05/25
