7 SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

8 An Act relating to insurance; granting the Oklahoma
9 Insurance Commissioner certain authority related to
10 the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act;
11 providing definition; providing for codification;
12 providing an effective date; and declaring an
13 emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4606 of Title 36, unless there
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. The Oklahoma Insurance Commissioner shall have the authority
19 to implement, establish, create, administer, or otherwise operate an
20 exchange, promulgate rules, and apply to the United States Secretary
21 of Health and Human Services for a waiver pursuant to Section 1332
22 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (42 U.S.C.,
23 Section 18052).

1 B. "Exchange" means a state, federal, or partnership exchange
2 or marketplace operating in Oklahoma pursuant to Section 1311 of the
3 Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

5 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
7 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
