17	1. "First responder" shall include a peace officer as defined
18	in Section 99 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, a correctional
19	or probation and parole officer, and an emergency medical technician
20	or emergency medical care provider; and
21	2. "Harass" means to willfully engage in a course of conduct
22	directed at a first responder which intentionally distracts the
23	first responder from performing his or her official duties and
24	serves no legitimate purpose.
