8	An Act relating to education; amending 70 O.S. 2021, Section 6-204.2, which relates to the Education
9	Leadership Oklahoma program; updating references; clarifying award coverage; increasing maximum amount
10	of award; changing conditions for repayment; authorizing reimbursement under certain conditions;
11	expanding certain mentor program; and providing an effective date.
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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 6-204.2, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 6-204.2. A. The Oklahoma Commission for Teacher
19	Preparation Commission for Educational Quality and Accountability
20	and the State Board of Education are authorized to establish the
21	Education Leadership Oklahoma program.
22	B. The purposes of the Education Leadership Oklahoma program
23	are to:
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Provide teachers throughout the state information about
 National Board certification and the Education Leadership Oklahoma
 program services;

2. Provide technical assistance and National-Board-certified
mentors to all teachers seeking National Board certification upon
request;

Reward teachers who are seeking National Board certification
by awarding them a portion of the application processing charge and
assessment fee and scholarship National Board certification cost as
provided in subsection D of this section; and

4. Provide recognition to National-Board-certified teachers.
 C. To fulfill the objectives of the Education Leadership
 Oklahoma Act, the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation shall:

Inform teachers of the Education Leadership Oklahoma program
 and services it provides to teachers seeking National Board
 certification, emphasizing recruiting efforts toward teachers at
 high-poverty schools, schools identified as in need of improvement
 and in <u>counties districts</u> with the lowest percentage of teachers who
 have achieved National Board certification; and

20 2. Ensure that all teachers seeking National Board
 21 certification receive adequate information regarding the level of
 22 commitment required to acquire National Board certification.

D. The Commission shall select not more than one hundred
 applicants to participate in the program each fiscal year for whom

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1 the Commission shall pay one-half (1/2) of the application 2 processing charge and assessment fee for National Board certification. The total amount paid by the Commission shall not 3 exceed One Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$1,300.00). In addition 4 5 the Commission shall also provide to the selected applicants a scholarship in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) to cover 6 7 other expenses associated with obtaining National Board certification up to One Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$1,800.00) 8 9 of the National Board certification cost. 10 The Commission shall promulgate rules establishing a process Ε. 11 for accepting applications for the Education Leadership Oklahoma 12 program and for providing to applicants selected for the program up-13 front payment of the application processing charge and assessment 14 fee and scholarship National Board certification cost. If a 15 selected applicant who receives the up-front payment does not 16 complete National Board certification within three (3) years fulfill 17 all submission requirements for National Board certification as 18 established by the certification vendor within the maximum allowable 19 time frame, the applicant will be required to repay the full amount 20 of the component fees paid on his or her behalf, the applicant shall 21 repay the Commission the full amount paid by the Commission pursuant 22 to subsection D of this section. All Subject to the availability of 23 funding, all selected applicants who do not receive an up-front 24 payment and successfully complete National Board certification shall

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be reimbursed by the Commission for the application processing charge and assessment fee <u>National Board certification cost</u>. The total amount of reimbursement paid by the Commission shall not exceed One Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$1,300.00) <u>One Thousand</u> Eight Hundred Dollars (\$1,800.00).

F. It is the intent of the Legislature that the Oklahoma
Commission for Teacher Preparation contract with Southeastern
Oklahoma State University to establish Education Leadership Oklahoma
program training in higher education teacher preparation programs in
the state to assist teachers in meeting the requirements to obtain
National Board certification.

12 G. All Subject to the availability of funding, all teachers 13 seeking initial National Board certification <u>either through the</u> 14 <u>Education Leadership Oklahoma Scholarship program or pay your own</u> 15 <u>way</u> shall be eligible to participate in Education Leadership 16 Oklahoma <u>program training mentoring for up to three (3) years</u> to 17 assist them in meeting the requirements of the National Board 18 certification process, free of charge.

H. G. Subject to district board of education policy or collective bargaining agreement, additional professional leave days may be granted to teachers seeking National Board certification for National Board certification portfolio development. During the two (2) days of the additional professional days granted to teachers for National Board certification portfolio development, a substitute

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1 teacher shall be provided by the school district at no cost to the 2 teacher.

I. H. 1. The State Board of Education shall provide to 3 4 teachers who attained National Board certification prior to June 30, 5 2013, a bonus in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) annually over a ten-year period, to be paid no later than January 31 6 7 each year. The Board shall provide a bonus to any teacher who attains National Board certification after June 30, 2013, if the 8 9 teacher was selected for the Education Leadership Oklahoma program before June 30, 2013, or the teacher has submitted an application 10 11 for National Board certification to the National Board for 12 Professional Teaching Standards before June 30, 2013.

13 2. The teachers eligible to receive the annual bonus as 14 provided for in paragraph 1 of this subsection shall receive the 15 annual bonus for the ten-year duration of their National Board 16 certification and so long as they are teaching in the classroom 17 full-time in an Oklahoma public school. No school or school 18 district shall be liable for payment of bonuses pursuant to this 19 section.

3. The bonus shall not be included in the calculation of the teacher's salary for purposes of meeting the district or statutory minimum salary schedule or for purposes of compensating Oklahoma Teachers' Retirement System contributions or benefits.

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4. Teachers eligible to receive the annual bonus as provided
 for in paragraph 1 of this subsection shall not be eligible to
 receive the additional salary increment for National Board
 certification as set forth in the minimum salary schedule in Section
 3 18-114.15 of this act title.

5. Teachers who attain National Board certification after June
30, 2013, shall be eligible to receive the additional salary
increments for National Board certification as set forth in the
minimum salary schedule in Section 3 <u>18-114.15</u> of this act <u>title</u>.
6. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules for a
process by which a National-Board-certified teacher will verify
that:

13 the National Board certification has not lapsed, a. 14 the teacher is still a full-time teacher, and b. 15 for teachers eligible for the bonus, the teacher has с. 16 not exceeded the limit of annual bonus payments as 17 provided for in paragraph 1 of this subsection. 18 It is the intent of the Legislature that the Oklahoma J. I. 19 State Regents for Higher Education incorporate the National Board 20 certification portfolio development into all programs in education 21 leading to a master's level degree. 22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.

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
