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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1501 of Title 60, unless there
18	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	A. Solar energy and industrial battery storage facilities,
20	excluding residential solar energy panels, shall have the following
21	setback requirements:
22	1. Shall not be located within five hundred (500) feet of an
23	occupied structure or occupied residence unless waived in writing by
24	the owner of the structure or residence;

1 2. Shall not be located within fifty (50) feet of any outer 2 boundary of the facility property; 3 3. Shall not be located within one hundred (100) feet from the 4 centerline of any public road; and 5 Shall not be located within a half (1/2) mile from any 6 public school or hospital. 7 This act shall apply to 10 megawatt and larger solar energy В. and industrial battery storage facilities. Furthermore, this act 8 shall apply to any project in development that does not yet have a 10 power purchase agreement in place on or after the effective date of this act. 11 12 SECTION 2.
