7 POLICY COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

8 An Act relating to property; providing setback  
9 requirements for solar energy and industrial battery  
10 storage facilities; providing for codification; and  
11 declaring an emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1501 of Title 60, unless there  
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 Solar energy and industrial battery storage facilities,  
17 excluding residential solar energy panels, shall have the following  
18 setback requirements:

19 1. Shall not be located within three hundred (300) feet of an  
20 occupied structure or occupied residence unless waived in writing by  
21 the owner of the structure or residence;

22 2. Shall not be located within one hundred (100) feet of any  
23 outer boundary of the facility property; and

1           3. Shall not be located within one hundred (100) feet from any  
2 public road right-of-way.

3           4. Shall not be located within one and one-half (1 1/2) miles  
4 from the centerline of any airport, public school, or hospital.

5           5. Shall not be located within two (2) miles from a wildlife  
6 refuge, wildlife management area, or any body of water used by  
7 migratory waterfowl.

8           SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
9 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
