8 An Act relating to military infrastructure funding;
9 creating the Base Infrastructure Needs and
10 Development - Technology Revolving Fund; establishing
11 the fund at the Oklahoma Military Department;
12 establishing revolving fund characteristics; deeming
13 funds appropriated; providing expenditure and
14 budgeting requirements and limitations; creating Base
15 Infrastructure Needs and Development - Technology
16 Program; establishing program at the Oklahoma
17 Military Department; authorizing certain utilizations
18 of funds; authorizing certain citations; providing
19 for codification; establishing an effective date; and
20 declaring an emergency.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 301B of Title 44, unless there
24 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

25 A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
26 fund for the Oklahoma Military Department to be designated the "Base
27 Infrastructure Needs and Development - Technology Revolving Fund",
28 which may also be cited as "BIND - Technology Fund". The fund shall

1 be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and
2 shall consist of all monies directed for deposit to the fund by law.
3 All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby
4 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma
5 Military Department for the purpose established in Subsection B of
6 this section. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon
7 warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as
8 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and
9 Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

10 B. There is hereby established within the Oklahoma Military
11 Department the "Base Infrastructure Needs and Development -
12 Technology Program", which may also be cited as the "BIND -
13 Technology Program". The Department shall utilize funds from the
14 BIND - Technology Fund created in Subsection A of this section,
15 alone or in combination with other available funding, to make
16 infrastructure investments, including, but not limited to, the
17 purchase of licenses and software associated with military
18 simulation training, that will either:

19 1. Decrease the likelihood of military base and other military
20 infrastructure closures in this state, or

21 2. Increase the likelihood of military base and other military
22 infrastructure expansions in this state.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

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1 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
