13	Section 2, Chapter 109, O.S.L. 2022 (28 O.S. Supp. 2024, Section 111), which relates to fees to be
14	charged by Secretary of State; transferring certain fees from Secretary of State to Oklahoma County
15	Clerk; updating statutory language; and providing a conditional effective date.
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18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
19	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 12A O.S. 2021, Section 1-9-320.2,
20	is amended to read as follows:
21	Section 1-9-320.2.
22	DEFINITIONS; REQUISITES OF AN
23	EFFECTIVE FINANCING STATEMENT
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As used in this section and Sections 1-9-320.1 through 1-9-320.7
of this title:

- 3 (a) "Buyer in the ordinary course of business" means a
 4 person who, in the ordinary course of business, buys
 5 farm products from a person engaged in farming
 6 operations who is in the business of selling farm
 7 products.
- 8 (b) "Central filing system" means a system for filing 9 effective financing statements on a statewide basis 10 and which has been certified by the Secretary of the 11 United States Department of Agriculture.
- (c) "Commission merchant" means any person engaged in the
 business of receiving any farm product for sale, on
 commission, or for or on behalf of another person.
- 15 (d) "Effective financing statement" means a statement 16 that:
- 17 (i) is an original or reproduced form consistent with
 18 the provisions of this act and approved by the
 19 Secretary of State Oklahoma County Clerk;
- 20 (ii) is signed and filed with the Secretary of State 21 Oklahoma County Clerk by the secured party; 22 (iii) is signed by the debtor;

23 (iv) contains:

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(A) the name and address of the secured party,

- (B) the name and address of the person indebted
 to the secured party,
 - (C) the social security number of the debtor or, in the case of a debtor doing business other than as an individual, the Internal Revenue Service taxpayer identification number of such debtor,
 - (D) the farm product name,
- 9 (E) each county in this state where the farm 10 product is produced or to be produced or a 11 blanket code covering all 77 Oklahoma 12 counties,
 - (F) a description of the farm products subject to the security interest only if needed to distinguish it from other such farm products owned by the same person or persons but not subject to the particular interest; and
- 18 (G) the crop year, unless every crop of the farm 19 product in question, for the duration of the 20 effective financing statement, is to be 21 subject to the particular security interest. 22 (v) (iv) must be amended in writing, within three

23 (3) months, similarly signed and filed, to
24 reflect material changes;

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1 (vi) (v) remains effective for a period of five (5) years from the date of filing, subject to 2 extensions for additional periods of five (5) 3 years each by refiling or filing a continuation 4 statement within six (6) months before the 5 expiration of the initial five-year period; 6 (vii) is not removed from the public database but 7 is not reported as an active files file when the 8 9 statement lapses on the expiration of the effective period of the statement or when a 10 termination statement from the secured party is 11 12 accepted, whichever occurs first; (viii) is accompanied by the requisite filing fee 13 provided for in Section 111 of Title 28 of the 14 Oklahoma Statutes; and 15 (ix) (viii) substantially complies with the 16 requirements of this paragraph even though it 17 contains minor errors that are not seriously 18 misleading. 19 (x) (ix) may reflect multiple products or products 20 in multiple counties. 21 (e) "Farm product" means an agricultural commodity such as 22 wheat, corn, soybeans, or a species of livestock such 23 as cattle, hogs, sheep, horses, or poultry used or 24

produced in farming operations, or a product of such crop or livestock in its unmanufactured state (such as ginned cotton, wool-clip, maple syrup, milk, and eggs), that is in the possession of a person engaged in farming operations.

- 6 (f) "Knows" or "knowledge" means actual knowledge.
- 7 (g) "Person" means any individual, partnership,
 8 corporation, limited liability company, trust, or any
 9 other business entity.
- (h) "Security interest" means an interest in farm products
 that secures payment or performance of an obligation.
- 12 (i) "Selling agent" means any person, other than a 13 commission merchant, who is engaged in the business of 14 negotiating the sale and purchase of any farm product

on behalf of a person engaged in farming operations.

16 (2) Unless otherwise provided for in this act, for purposes of 17 this section and Sections 4 and 6 of this act, receipt of notice 18 shall be presumed if notice is sent by first-class mail, postage 19 prepaid.

9	PROTECTION OF BUYERS OF FARM PRODUCTS,
10	COMMISSION MERCHANTS AND SELLING AGENTS
11	A buyer of farm products, commission merchant, or selling agent
12	who purchases or sells farm products in the ordinary course of
13	business from or for a person engaged in farming operations takes
14	subject to a security interest in the farm products if:
15	(a) (i) the buyer of the farm products, commission merchant,
16	or selling agent has failed to register with the
17	Secretary of State Oklahoma County Clerk prior to the
18	purchase of the farm products and the secured party
19	has filed an effective financing statement that covers
20	the farm products being sold; or
21	(ii) the buyer of farm products, commission merchant or
22	selling agent receives from the Secretary of State
23	Oklahoma County Clerk written notice as provided in
24	paragraph (d) or (f) of subsection (4) of Section 1-9-

1 320.6 of this title, and the buyer of farm products, commission merchant or selling agent does not secure a 2 waiver or release of the security interest specified 3 in an effective financing statement from the secured 4 5 party by performing any payment obligation or otherwise; or 6 the secured party or the seller provides written notice of 7 (b) the security interest pursuant to the provisions of Section 8 9 1-9-320.7 of this title. 12A O.S. 2021, Section 1-9-320.6, 10 SECTION 4. AMENDATORY as amended by Section 1, Chapter 109, O.S.L. 2022 (12A O.S. Supp. 11 2024, Section 1-9-320.6), is amended to read as follows: 12 13 Section 1-9-320.6. CENTRAL FILING SYSTEM RELATING TO FARM PRODUCTS 14 The Secretary of State Oklahoma County Clerk shall be 15 (1)responsible for developing and implementing maintaining the central 16 17 filing system. This responsibility shall include obtaining the necessary certification for the system from the United States 18 Department of Agriculture ("USDA") (USDA). The effective date for 19 the implementation of the central filing system was October 24, 1988 20

21 <u>shall be one hundred eighty (180) days from the certification of the</u> 22 central filing system by the USDA.

(2) The Secretary of State Oklahoma County Clerk may
 promulgate, in accordance with the applicable provisions of the

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1	Administrative Procedures Act, laws governing business within its
2	office, appropriate rules and practices of the filing office in
3	harmony with the rules and practices of filing offices in other
4	jurisdictions that enact substantially this part and to keep the
5	technology used by the filing office compatible with the technology
6	used by filing offices in other jurisdictions that enact
7	substantially this part. The Oklahoma County Clerk, so far as is
8	consistent with the purposes, policies, and provisions of this
9	article in adopting, amending, and repealing filing office rules,
10	shall:
11	(a) consult with filing offices in other jurisdictions
12	that enact substantially this part,
13	(b) consult the International Association of Commercial
14	Administrators or any successor organization, and
15	(c) take into consideration the rules and practices of,
16	and the technology used by, filing offices in other
17	jurisdictions that enact substantially this part, for
18	the implementation and operation of the central filing
19	system.
20	(3) The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall
21	assist the Secretary of State in developing and implementing the
22	central filing system.
23	(4) The central filing system shall conform to the following
24	requirements:

1	(a) The Secretary of State Oklahoma County Clerk shall
2	record the date and, hour, minute, and second of the
3	filing of each effective financing statement;
4	(b) The Secretary of State Oklahoma County Clerk shall
5	compile all effective financing statements into a
6	master list:
7	(i) organized according to farm products;
8	(ii) arranged within each such product:
9	(A) in alphabetical order according to the last
10	name of the individual debtors or, in the
11	case of debtors doing business other than as
12	individuals, the first word in the name of
13	the debtors;
14	(B) in numerical order according to the Social
15	Security number of the individual debtors
16	or, in the case of debtors doing business
17	other than as individuals, the Internal
18	Revenue Service taxpayer identification
19	number of the debtors;
20	(C) geographically by county produced; and
21	(D) by crop year; and
22	(iii) containing the information provided for in
23	subparagraph (iv) of paragraph (d) of Section 1-
24	9-320.2 of this title ;

1	(iv) portions of the master list shall be available in
2	hard copy, electronic formats, or via Internet
3	download, and may be organized by other sorting
4	methods in addition to the methods listed above.
5	(c) The Secretary of State Oklahoma County Clerk shall
6	maintain records of all buyers of farm products,
7	commission merchants, selling agents and others who
8	register with the Secretary of State, on a form
9	containing:
10	(i) the name and address of each registrant;
11	(ii) the information on the farm product or products
12	that the registrant is requesting;
13	(iii) the name of each county where the product is
14	produced or to be produced, or a blanket code
15	covering all seventy-seven (77) counties of this
16	state; and
17	(iv) an authorized signature.
18	(d) (i) A copy of those portions of the master list
19	covering the information requested by a
20	registrant shall be distributed to such
21	registrants by the Secretary of State Oklahoma
22	<u>County Clerk</u> on or before the last business day
23	of each month and shall be presumed to have been
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received by the third business day of the following month.

- (ii) Registrants shall be deemed to be registered only as to those portions of the master list for which they register, and shall be deemed to have failed to register and shall not be considered to be registrants as to those portions for which they do not register.
- 9 (iii) Registrants are subject only to security 10 interests shown on the portions of the master 11 list which they receive as a consequence of 12 registration with the Secretary of State Oklahoma 13 County Clerk.
- 14 (iv) If a particular security interest is shown on the 15 master list, but was included since the last 16 regular distribution of portions of the master 17 list to registrants, registrants shall not be 18 subject to that security interest;
- (e) The duration of the registration with the Secretary of
 State of a buyer of farm products, commission
 merchant, selling agent or other registrant shall be
 one (1) year from the effective date of the
 registration with the Secretary of State Oklahoma
 County Clerk.

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1 (f) (i) Upon request, within twenty-four (24) hours of any inquiry, for information, the Secretary of 2 State Oklahoma County Clerk shall provide verbal 3 confirmation of the existence or nonexistence of 4 5 any effective financing statement on file. By the close of the business day following the day 6 on which the request was received, written 7 confirmation of the existence of an effective 8 9 financing statement will be provided to buyers of farm products, commission merchants, and selling 10 agents who have not registered, and others who 11 12 request it. 13 (ii) The state or political subdivision shall not be

liable if a loss or claim results from any 14 confirmation of the existence or nonexistence of 15 any effective financing statement on file in the 16 17 Office of the Secretary of State Oklahoma County Clerk's office made in good faith by an employee 18 of the Office of the Secretary of State Oklahoma 19 County Clerk's office as required by the 20 provisions of this section. 21

(5) (4) The filing in the office of the Secretary of State
 Oklahoma County Clerk under this section shall be in addition to the
 filing requirements provided for in this article.

1 (6) (5) A financing or continuation statement covering farm 2 products that has not lapsed and which was filed pursuant to this title between December 23, 1986, and October 24, 1988, inclusive, 3 and for which no written notice was furnished as provided in Section 4 5 1-9-320.7 of this title, shall become ineffective as to a buyer of farm products, commission merchant or selling agent, unless the 6 secured party files an effective financing statement in the office 7 of the Secretary of State Oklahoma County Clerk. 8

9 (7) (6) An effective financing statement shall not be deemed 10 filed in accordance with the provisions of this section until all 11 fees authorized by Section 111 of Title 28 of the Oklahoma Statutes 12 relating to the filing of the statement are tendered to the 13 Secretary of State Oklahoma County Clerk.

(8) (7) The secured party shall file a termination statement 14 within twenty (20) days after there is no outstanding secured 15 obligation or commitment to make advances, incur obligations or 16 otherwise give value. The termination statement shall refer to the 17 unique document ID number. The secured party shall not be required 18 to file a termination statement if the debtor, in writing, addressed 19 to the secured party, requests that a termination not be filed. 20 The request shall be signed by the debtor or an authorized 21 representative and the request may be made at any time prior to the 22 expiration date of an effective financing statement set forth 23 herein. If the affected secured party fails to file a termination 24

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statement as required by this subsection, the party shall be liable to the Secretary of State Oklahoma County Clerk for Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00). In addition the affected secured party shall be liable to the debtor for any loss caused to the debtor by the failure to terminate the effective financing statement.

(9) (8) The Attorney General Oklahoma County District Attorney 6 shall be responsible for enforcing the provisions of subsection (8) 7 (7) of this section on behalf of the Secretary of State Oklahoma 8 9 County Clerk and is authorized to take appropriate actions to 10 collect any penalties owed to the Secretary of State Oklahoma County Clerk pursuant to subsection $\frac{(8)}{(7)}$ (7) of this section. When 11 12 collected, the Oklahoma County District Attorney General shall cause 13 the penalty to be deposited into the Central Filing System Revolving Fund Oklahoma County Clerk's Uniform Commercial Code Central Filing 14 Fund created pursuant to Section 276.3 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma 15 Statutes Section 1-9-525.1 of Title 12A of the Oklahoma Statutes. 16 As the purpose of an effective financing statement filing 17 (9) is to ensure that a joint check is made payable to the debtor and 18 all applicable secured parties, there shall be no priority among 19 filings. Filings shall be processed according to the order in which 20 they were filed, as recorded in a timestamp within the filing. 21 (10) All active filings on the effective date of this act, as 22 provided in paragraph (1) of this section, shall be filed with the 23 Oklahoma County Clerk's office. Each active filing that is filed 24

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1	pursuant to the requirements of this paragraph shall be accompanied
2	with a transition document that shall be provided by the Oklahoma
3	County Clerk's office. The Oklahoma County Clerk's office shall
4	charge no fee for active filings that are migrated to the system
5	maintained by the Oklahoma County Clerk.

15	writing and consists of one to five pages, and an additional One
16	Dollar (\$1.00) per page for each page exceeding five; and
17	(2) Ten Dollars (\$10.00) if the record is communicated by an
18	electronic medium authorized by filing-office rule.
19	(b) The number of names required to be indexed does not affect
20	the amount of the fee in subsection (a) of this section.
21	(c) The fee for responding to a request for information from
22	the filing office in any medium designated by the filing office,
23	including issuing a certificate showing whether there is on file any
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1 financing statement naming a particular debtor, is Ten Dollars
2 (\$10.00) for each debtor.

3 (d) The fee for a copy of a record is One Dollar (\$1.00) per4 page regardless of the medium used.

5 This section does not require a fee with respect to a (e) record of a mortgage which is effective as a financing statement 6 filed as a fixture filing or as a financing statement covering as-7 extracted collateral or timber to be cut under subsection (c) of 8 Section 1-9-502 of this title. However, the recording and 9 satisfaction fees that otherwise would be applicable to the record 10 of the mortgage apply pursuant to paragraphs 1, 2, 4, 7, 11, 15 and 11 16 of subsection A of Section 32 of Title 28 of the Oklahoma 12 13 Statutes.

14 (f) The fee for providing certified copies shall be One Dollar15 (\$1.00) per page regardless of medium.

16 (g) The fee for providing bulk data of indexed records as 17 described in subsection (f) of Section 1-9-523 of this title is as 18 follows:

19 (1) Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for the initial database 20 history.

(2) Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for weekly updates to the database.
(3) Four cents (\$0.04) per page for images of filed records.
(h) The filing office may accept payment for fees by automated
clearing house or by a nationally recognized debit or credit card.

1 If payment is made by a credit or debit card, the filing office may 2 add an amount equal to the amount of the service charge incurred for the acceptance of the payment. 10. The Secretary of State shall collect a fee of Twenty-five
Dollars (\$25.00) for every apostille issued. For the purposes of

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1 this paragraph, an apostille is a special certificate attached to a public record, as required by the 1961 Hague Convention, Fed. R. 2 Civ. P. 44 (28 U.S.C.A.), to certify the authenticity of the 3 signature, the capacity in which the person signing the document has 4 5 acted and, where appropriate, the identity of the seal or stamp which it bears; provided, however, a fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) 6 shall be collected for any apostille requested for an international 7 adoption not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for the 8 9 adoption of each child; and

10 11. For each service rendered and not specified in this 11 section, such fees as are allowed for similar services in other 12 cases.

B. All fees shall be properly accounted for and shall be paid 13 into the State Treasury monthly. The fees generated by paragraphs 14 1, 2, 10 and 11 of subsection A of this section shall be deposited 15 to the credit of the Revolving Fund for the Office of the Secretary 16 17 of State created pursuant to Section 276.1 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The fees generated by paragraphs 3 through 9 of 18 subsection A of this section and other fees collected by the central 19 filing system shall be deposited to the credit of the Central Filing 20 System Revolving Fund created pursuant to Section 276.3 of Title 62 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes. 22

23 SECTION 7. This act shall become effective one hundred eighty 24 (180) days from the certification of the central filing system by

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1	the USDA, pursuant to the implementation effective date set forth in
2	Section 1-9-320.6 of Title 12A of the Oklahoma Statutes. Upon the
3	occurrence of such implementation, the Oklahoma County Clerk shall
4	issue a formal notification to the President Pro Tempore of the
5	Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Governor,
6	and the Secretary of State indicating that the contingency has been
7	met and the amendments shall take effect.
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
