7	2, Chapter 357, O.S.L. 2023 (26 O.S. Supp. 2024, Section 4-120), which relates to cancellation of		
8	voter registrations; requiring cancellation of voter registration under certain circumstance; authorizing		
9	the Secretary of the State Election Board to conduct voter registration list comparison with certain		
10	entities; requiring provision of notice of non- citizenship to certain voter; requiring furnishing of		
11	proof of citizenship to certain county election board; providing for cancellation of voter		
12	registration under certain circumstance; defining term; authorizing promulgation of rules for certain		
13	purposes; amending 26 O.S. 2021, Section 7-103.2, as last amended by Section 2, Chapter 264, O.S.L. 2023		
14 15	(26 O.S. Supp. 2024, Section 7-103.2), which relates to voter registration list; specifying qualifications for access to certain list; requiring application for		
15	certain access; prohibiting access to voter registration list for certain purpose; prohibiting		
10	transmission of list to certain foreign entities; providing for codification; and providing an

20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:		
21	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 4-120, as		
22	last amended by Section 2, Chapter 357, O.S.L. 2023 (26 O.S. Supp.		
23	2024, Section 4-120), is amended to read as follows:		
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1 Section 4-120. A. The registration of any registered voter shall be canceled only for one of the following reasons: 2 1. Written notice from the voter pursuant to Section 4-120.1 of 3 this title; 4 2. Death; 5 3. Conviction of a felony; 6 4. Judicial determination of mental incapacitation under Title 7 30 of the Oklahoma Statutes; 8 9 5. Registration in another county or state; 6. Failure to respond to a confirmation of address mailing and 10 failure to vote as prescribed in Section 4-120.2 of this title; 11 7. The surrendering of the voter's Oklahoma driver license to 12 13 Service Oklahoma upon being issued a driver license in another state; or 14 8. Being excused from jury duty for not being a citizen of the 15 United States; or 16 9. Determination that the voter is not a citizen of the United 17 18 States. B. For purposes of this section, paragraphs 5 and 7 of 19 subsection A of this section shall constitute confirmation from the 20 voter to cancel his or her voter registration due to a change of 21 residence. 22 23 24

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C. A list of voter registrations that were canceled during the previous twenty-four (24) months, and the reason for the cancellation, shall be made available to the public.

4 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4-122 of Title 26, unless there 6 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Secretary of the State Election Board may compare the
list of registered voters in this state with the database of any
federal, state, or local agency, board, or commission that maintains
information regarding the citizenship of persons residing in this
state.

12 Β. If a registered voter definitively matches a person who is recorded in a database described in subsection A of this section as 13 not being a citizen of the United States, the Secretary or his or 14 her designee shall send a notice of such finding to the voter. The 15 voter shall, within thirty (30) days from the date the notice is 16 sent to the voter, present proof of citizenship to the secretary of 17 the county election board in the county where the voter is 18 registered. 19

20 C. If a voter fails to present proof of citizenship within the 21 prescribed time to the county election board or otherwise provides 22 notice that the voter is not a citizen, then the voter's 23 registration shall be canceled, and the voter shall be reported to 24 the appropriate district attorney and United States attorney.

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D. For purposes of this section, "proof of citizenship" shall mean the requirements for proof of citizenship pursuant to the provisions of the REAL ID Act of 2005, Public Law No. 109-13.

4 E. The Secretary shall promulgate rules and procedures as5 necessary to effectuate the provisions of this section.

6 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 7-103.2, as
7 last amended by Section 2, Chapter 264, O.S.L. 2023 (26 O.S. Supp.
8 2024, Section 7-103.2), is amended to read as follows:

9 Section 7-103.2. A. 1. County election boards shall maintain
10 a current list of all registered voters in each precinct, which will
11 reflect the address and party affiliation of each voter. The list
12 shall be public information.

13 2. The list shall only be shared with a court system if that
14 court system agrees to regularly provide the names of persons
15 convicted of a felony in that court system to the Secretary of the
16 State Election Board and the appropriate secretary of a county
17 election board, or if the court system is required by state law to
18 provide such information.

The list shall note any voter for whom a first-class mailing
 from the county election board or the State Election Board was
 returned undeliverable.

B. <u>1.</u> The Secretary of the State Election Board shall ensure
that an electronic copy of the voter registration list described in

2	of charge <u>, to t</u>	he following:

19	<u>c.</u> <u>a</u>	ny additional information deemed necessary by the
20	S	ecretary.
21	3. It shal	l be unlawful for the recipient of a voter
22	registration li	st to use such list for commercial purposes.
23	Provided, for t	he purposes of this section, a commercial purpose
24	shall not inclu	de the use of the voter list by campaigns, political

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1	parties, government officials, or public opinion pollsters to
2	contact or interact with voters.
3	4. It shall be unlawful for the recipient of a voter
4	registration list to knowingly provide such list to a foreign
5	national, foreign commercial interest, or foreign government entity.
6	SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
