Personal electronic devices shall not include school-issued or schoolapproved devices that are specifically limited for use in classroom instruction.

B. 1. For the 2025-2026 school year, each school district board of education shall adopt a policy prohibiting students from using cell phones and personal electronic devices while on the campus of a public school district from bell to bell. The policy shall include disciplinary procedures for violations.

12 2. For the 2026-2027 school year and each school year 13 thereafter, each school district board of education may adopt a 14 policy prohibiting students from using cell phones and personal 15 electronic devices while on the campus of a public school district 16 from bell to bell.

17 C. The policy adopted pursuant to subsection B of this section18 may provide for exceptions including, but not limited to:

Emergency use of cell phones or personal electronic devices
by students during the school day; and

21 2. Use of cell phones or personal electronic devices by22 students who use them to monitor health issues.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.
