BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 40 O.S. 2021, Section 197.16, is
amended to read as follows:
Section 197.16. <u>A.</u> To compute the minimum wage of any employee
coming within the purview of this act <u>the Oklahoma Minimum Wage Act</u> ,
credit toward the minimum required wage must shall be given for any
tips or gratuities, meals, or lodging received by the employee up to
but not exceeding fifty percent (50%) of said <u>the</u> wage.
B. To compute the minimum wage of any employee coming within
the purview of the Oklahoma Minimum Wage Act should the minimum wage
exceed the current federal minimum wage, credit toward the minimum
required wage may be given for any tips or gratuities, meals, or
lodging received by the employee.
