- B. After the occurrence of a mass casualty event caused by a violent crime, as defined in Section 571 of Title 57 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation may respond to the incident without a request from a law enforcement agency and coordinate with local law enforcement agencies that are responding to the event.
- SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 151.5 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to be designated the "Mass Casualty Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation from legislative appropriations, federal grants, or funds from any other source provided for the purpose of investigating mass casualty events. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation for the purpose provided for in this act.

Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
