6 An Act relating to impaired driving; amending Section  
7 1, Chapter 265, O.S.L. 2024 (47 O.S. Supp. 2024,  
8 Section 6-212.7), which relates to the Impaired  
9 Driving Prevention Advisory Committee; adding certain  
10 members; updating statutory language; and providing  
11 an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 265, O.S.L.  
14 2024 (47 O.S. Supp. 2024, Section 6-212.7), is amended to read as  
15 follows:

16 Section 6-212.7. A. There is hereby created the Impaired  
17 Driving Prevention Advisory Committee. The Committee shall be  
18 comprised of:

- 19 1. The Commissioner of Public Safety, or a designee, who shall  
20 act as the ~~Chair~~ chair;
- 21 2. The Chief of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, or a designee;
- 22 3. A member appointed by the District Attorneys Council;
- 23 4. A member appointed by the Administrative Office of the  
24 Courts;

- 1        5. The ~~Director of the Department~~ Commissioner of Mental Health  
2 and Substance Abuse Services, or a designee;
- 3        6. The Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation,  
4 or a designee;
- 5        7. The State Director ~~of the Board~~ of Tests for Alcohol and  
6 Drug Influence, or a designee;
- 7        8. The Director of the Oklahoma Highway Safety Office, or a  
8 designee;
- 9        9. The President of the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of  
10 Police, or a designee;
- 11       10. The President of the Oklahoma Sheriff's Association, or a  
12 designee;
- 13       11. The ~~Chief Executive Officer~~ Director of Service Oklahoma,  
14 or a designee;
- 15       12. A member of the Board of Directors of Safety and Advocacy  
16 For Empowerment (SAFE);
- 17       13. A representative designated by a victim advocacy group to  
18 be selected by the Commissioner of Public Safety;
- 19       14. A member of the ~~Oklahoma~~ House of Representatives appointed  
20 by the Speaker of the ~~Oklahoma~~ House of Representatives; ~~and~~
- 21       15. A member of the ~~Oklahoma State~~ Senate appointed by the  
22 President Pro Tempore of the ~~Oklahoma State~~ Senate;
- 23       16. The State Commissioner of Health, or a designee;
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1        17. The Executive Director of the Department of Transportation,  
2 or a designee;

3        18. The Executive Director of the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana  
4 Authority, or a designee;

5        19. The Executive Director of the State Board of Pharmacy, or a  
6 designee;

7        20. The Executive Director of the Alcoholic Beverage Laws  
8 Enforcement Commission, or a designee;

9        21. The Executive Director of the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority,  
10 or a designee; and

11        22. The Executive Director of the Oklahoma Indigent Defense  
12 System, or a designee.

13        B. The Department of Public Safety shall provide administrative  
14 support necessary for the Committee to accomplish the goals and  
15 objectives assigned by this section.

16        C. The Committee shall meet at the direction of the chair, and  
17 shall meet not less than once a year, but not more than four times a  
18 year. A vice chair shall be elected by the Committee from among its  
19 members. The vice chair shall act as chair of the Committee in the  
20 absence of the chair.

21        D. The Committee is authorized to collect, analyze, and  
22 interpret relevant crash data on impaired driving and associated  
23 traffic crashes. In addition, the Committee is authorized to  
24 review, evaluate, and monitor the impaired driving system of this

1 state and provide a network of communication and cooperation among  
2 the various stakeholders to coordinate and integrate efforts and  
3 resources to reduce the incidence and severity of impaired driving  
4 crashes.

5 E. The Committee shall annually complete a statewide strategic  
6 plan to reduce the incidents of impaired driving and impaired  
7 driving crashes. The plan shall be submitted no later than December  
8 31 of each year to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the  
9 ~~Oklahoma State~~ Senate, and the Speaker of the ~~Oklahoma~~ House of  
10 Representatives.

11 F. Members of the Committee who are otherwise employed by a  
12 state agency or political subdivision shall serve without additional  
13 compensation. Members of the Committee who are otherwise employed  
14 by a state agency or political subdivision shall be entitled to  
15 reimbursement for any actual and necessary traveling expenses in  
16 accordance with the State Travel Reimbursement Act from the  
17 employing agency.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.  
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
