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- (a) "Buyer in the ordinary course of business" means a
 person who, in the ordinary course of business, buys
 farm products from a person engaged in farming
 operations who is in the business of selling farm
 products.
 - (b) "Central filing system" means a system for filing effective financing statements on a statewide basis and which has been certified by the Secretary of the United States Department of Agriculture.
- (c) "Commission merchant" means any person engaged in the
 business of receiving any farm product for sale, on
 commission, or for or on behalf of another person.
- 13 (d) "Effective financing statement" means a statement 14 that:
- (i) is an original or reproduced form consistent with
 the provisions of this act and approved by the
 Secretary of State Oklahoma County Clerk;
- (ii) is signed and filed with the Secretary of State
 Oklahoma County Clerk by the secured party;
 - (iii) is signed by the debtor;

(iv) contains:

(A) the name and address of the secured party,
(B) the name and address of the person indebted
to the secured party,

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1	(C)	the social security number of the debtor or,
2		in the case of a debtor doing business other
3		than as an individual, the Internal Revenue
4		Service taxpayer identification number of
5		such debtor,
6	(D)	the farm product name,
7	(E)	each county in this state where the farm
8		product is produced or to be produced or a
9		blanket code covering all 77 Oklahoma
10		counties,
11	(F)	a description of the farm products subject
12		to the security interest only if needed to
13		distinguish it from other such farm products
14		owned by the same person or persons but not
15		subject to the particular interest; and

17		product in question, for the duration of the
18		effective financing statement, is to be
19		subject to the particular security interest.

ginned cotton, wool-clip, maple syrup, milk, and eggs), that is in the possession of a person engaged in farming operations.

- 4 (f) "Knows" or "knowledge" means actual knowledge.
- 5 (g) "Person" means any individual, partnership,
 6 corporation, limited liability company, trust, or any
 7 other business entity.
 - (h) "Security interest" means an interest in farm products that secures payment or performance of an obligation.
- (i) "Selling agent" means any person, other than a
 commission merchant, who is engaged in the business of
 negotiating the sale and purchase of any farm product
 on behalf of a person engaged in farming operations.

14 (2) Unless otherwise provided for in this act, for purposes of 15 this section and Sections 4 and 6 of this act, receipt of notice 16 shall be presumed if notice is sent by first-class mail, postage 17 prepaid.

15	necessary certification for the system from the United States
16	Department of Agriculture $\frac{(USDA')}{(USDA)}$. The effective date for
17	the implementation of the central filing system was October 24, 1988
18	shall be one hundred eighty (180) days from the certification of the
19	central filing system by the USDA.
20	(2) The Secretary of State <u>Oklahoma County Clerk</u> may
21	promulgate, in accordance with the applicable provisions of the
22	Administrative Procedures Act, laws governing business within its
23	office, appropriate rules and practices of the filing office in
24	harmony with the rules and practices of filing offices in other

1	jurisdictions that enact substantially this part and to keep the
2	technology used by the filing office compatible with the technology

4	substantially this part. The Oklahoma County Clerk, so far as is
5	consistent with the purposes, policies, and provisions of this
6	article in adopting, amending, and repealing filing office rules,

18	assist the Secretary of State in developing and implementing the

20	(4) The central filing system shall conform to the following

23	record the date and, hour, minute, and second of the
24	filing of each effective financing statement;

1	(b) The Secretary of State Oklahoma County Clerk shall
2	compile all effective financing statements into a
3	master list:

5	(ii) arranged within each such product:
6	(A) in alphabetical order according to the last
7	name of the individual debtors or, in the

9	individuals, the first word in the name of

11	(B) in numerical order according to the Social

14	other than as individuals, the Internal
15	Revenue Service taxpayer identification
16	number of the debtors;
17	(C) geographically by county produced; and
18	(D) by crop year; and
19	(iii) containing the information provided for in
20	subparagraph (iv) of paragraph (d) of Section 1-
21	9-320.2 of this title ;
22	(iv) portions of the master list shall be available in
23	hard copy, electronic formats, or via Internet
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1	download, and may be organized by other sorting
2	methods in addition to the methods listed above.
3	(c) The Secretary of State Oklahoma County Clerk shall
4	maintain records of all buyers of farm products,
5	commission merchants, selling agents and others who
6	register with the Secretary of State, on a form
7	containing:
8	(i) the name and address of each registrant;
9	(ii) the information on the farm product or products
10	that the registrant is requesting;
11	(iii) the name of each county where the product is
12	produced or to be produced, or a blanket code
13	covering all seventy-seven (77) counties of this
14	state; and
15	(iv) an authorized signature.
16	(d) (i) A copy of those portions of the master list
17	covering the information requested by a
18	registrant shall be distributed to such
19	registrants by the Secretary of State Oklahoma
20	County Clerk on or before the last business day
21	of each month and shall be presumed to have been
22	received by the third business day of the
23	following month.
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- 1(ii) Registrants shall be deemed to be registered only2as to those portions of the master list for which3they register, and shall be deemed to have failed4to register and shall not be considered to be5registrants as to those portions for which they6do not register.
- 7 (iii) Registrants are subject only to security
 8 interests shown on the portions of the master
 9 list which they receive as a consequence of
 10 registration with the Secretary of State Oklahoma
 11 County Clerk.
- 12 (iv) If a particular security interest is shown on the 13 master list, but was included since the last 14 regular distribution of portions of the master 15 list to registrants, registrants shall not be 16 subject to that security interest;
- 17 (e) The duration of the registration with the Secretary of
 18 State of a buyer of farm products, commission
 19 merchant, selling agent or other registrant shall be
 20 one (1) year from the effective date of the
 21 registration with the Secretary of State Oklahoma
 22 County Clerk.
- (f) (i) Upon request, within twenty-four (24) hours of
 any inquiry, for information, the Secretary of

State Oklahoma County Clerk shall provide verbal confirmation of the existence or nonexistence of any effective financing statement on file. By the close of the business day following the day on which the request was received, written confirmation of the existence of an effective financing statement will be provided to buyers of farm products, commission merchants, and selling agents who have not registered, and others who request it.

The state or political subdivision shall not be (ii) 11 liable if a loss or claim results from any 12 13 confirmation of the existence or nonexistence of any effective financing statement on file in the 14 Office of the Secretary of State Oklahoma County 15 Clerk's office made in good faith by an employee 16 of the Office of the Secretary of State Oklahoma 17 County Clerk's office as required by the 18 provisions of this section. 19

20 (5) (4) The filing in the office of the Secretary of State
21 Oklahoma County Clerk under this section shall be in addition to the
22 filing requirements provided for in this article.

23 (6) (5) A financing or continuation statement covering farm
24 products that has not lapsed and which was filed pursuant to this

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title between December 23, 1986, and October 24, 1988, inclusive, and for which no written notice was furnished as provided in Section 1-9-320.7 of this title, shall become ineffective as to a buyer of farm products, commission merchant or selling agent, unless the secured party files an effective financing statement in the office of the Secretary of State Oklahoma County Clerk.

7 (7) (6) An effective financing statement shall not be deemed
8 filed in accordance with the provisions of this section until all
9 fees authorized by Section 111 of Title 28 of the Oklahoma Statutes
10 relating to the filing of the statement are tendered to the
11 Secretary of State Oklahoma County Clerk.

12 (8) (7) The secured party shall file a termination statement within twenty (20) days after there is no outstanding secured 13 obligation or commitment to make advances, incur obligations or 14 otherwise give value. The termination statement shall refer to the 15 unique document ID number. The secured party shall not be required 16 to file a termination statement if the debtor, in writing, addressed 17 to the secured party, requests that a termination not be filed. 18 The request shall be signed by the debtor or an authorized 19 representative and the request may be made at any time prior to the 20 expiration date of an effective financing statement set forth 21 herein. If the affected secured party fails to file a termination 22 statement as required by this subsection, the party shall be liable 23 to the Secretary of State Oklahoma County Clerk for Five Hundred 24

(9) (8) The Attorney General Oklahoma County District Attorney 4 5 shall be responsible for enforcing the provisions of subsection (8) (7) of this section on behalf of the Secretary of State Oklahoma 6 County Clerk and is authorized to take appropriate actions to 7 collect any penalties owed to the Secretary of State Oklahoma County 8 9 Clerk pursuant to subsection $\frac{(8)}{(7)}$ (7) of this section. 12 B. All fees shall be properly accounted for and shall be paid into the State Treasury monthly. The fees generated by paragraphs 13 1, 2, 10 and 11 of subsection A of this section shall be deposited 14 to the credit of the Revolving Fund for the Office of the Secretary 15 of State created pursuant to Section 276.1 of Title 62 of the 16 17 Oklahoma Statutes. The fees generated by paragraphs 3 through 9 of subsection A of this section and other fees collected by the central 18 filing system shall be deposited to the credit of the Central Filing 19 System Revolving Fund created pursuant to Section 276.3 of Title 62 20 of the Oklahoma Statutes. 21

22 SECTION 7. This act shall become effective one hundred eighty 23 (180) days from the certification of the central filing system by 24 the USDA, pursuant to the implementation effective date set forth in
