"Abortion-inducing drug" means a medicine, drug, or any 3 2. 4 other substance prescribed or dispensed with the intent of inducing 5 an abortion. This includes off-label use of drugs known to have abortion-inducing properties, which are prescribed specifically with 6 7 the intent of causing an abortion, such as misoprostol (Cytotec) and methotrexate. This definition does not apply to drugs that may be 8 9 known to cause an abortion but which are prescribed for other medical indications, such as chemotherapeutic agents or diagnostic 10 11 drugs, or for treatment of an ectopic pregnancy or spontaneous 12 miscarriage;

3. "Preventive contraception" means any drug, chemical, biological product, or device used with the intent to prevent pregnancy and that is used in accordance with manufacturer instructions;

4. "Trafficking" means the act of buying, selling, ordelivering medicine, drugs, or any substance illegally; and

19 5. "Unborn child" means the unborn offspring of human beings 20 from the moment of conception, through pregnancy, and until live 21 birth, including the human conceptus, zygote, morula, blastocyst, 22 embryo, and fetus.

B. A person who knows or has reason to know that another person intends to use an abortion-inducing drug to cause an unlawful abortion and who knowingly or intentionally:

Delivers an abortion-inducing drug to that person; or
Possesses an abortion-inducing drug with the intent to
deliver the abortion-inducing drug to that person,
commits trafficking in an abortion-inducing drug and is guilty of a

8 felony upon conviction.

9 C. A person convicted of trafficking or attempting to traffic 10 abortion-inducing drugs shall be guilty of a felony punishable by a 11 fine not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00), or by 12 confinement in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a 13 term not to exceed ten (10) years, or by both such fine and 14 imprisonment.

D. This act does not apply to a pharmacist or a manufacturer or distributor of drugs or surgical supplies who lawfully manufactures, possesses, offers, sells, or distributes, in the usual course of that entity's business or profession, any drug, medicine, or instrument intended for any lawful medical purpose.

E. Nothing in this act may be construed to prohibit the use, sale, prescription, or administration of a preventive contraceptive measure, drug, chemical, or device if the preventive contraceptive measure, drug, chemical, or device is used, sold, prescribed, or administered in accordance with manufacturer instructions.
