16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 5, Chapter 148, O.S.L.
17	2024 (16 O.S. Supp. 2024, Section 305), is amended to read as
18	follows:
19	Section 305. 1. Recording an unfair service agreement is
20	prohibited. No person shall record or cause to be recorded an
21	unfair service agreement or notice or memorandum thereof in this
22	state;
23	2. A county clerk's office shall refuse to accept for
24	recordation an unfair service agreement or notice or memorandum;

Т	3. In the event that a county treek does activentally record an
2	unfair service agreement or notice or memorandum, the county clerk
3	shall incur no liability for doing so; and
4	4. If an unfair service agreement or notice or memorandum is
5	recorded in this state, it shall not provide actual or constructive
6	notice against an otherwise bona fide purchaser or, creditor, or
7	title company; and
