Any active employee eligible

to participate or who is a participant opting out of coverage

2	insurance plan participation and sign an affidavit attesting that

5	opting out of the state's basic plan or the health and dental basic

7	Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) in lieu of the flexible benefit amount the
