14	licensing agreement; authorizing certain payment; and providing an effective date.

18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
19	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 1135.3, as
20	last amended by Section 85, Chapter 452, O.S.L. 2024 (47 O.S. Supp.
21	2024, Section 1135.3), is amended to read as follows:
22	Section 1135.3. A. Service Oklahoma is hereby authorized to
23	design and issue appropriate official special license plates to
24	persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest or membership to or

1 for an organization, occupation, cause or other subject as provided
2 by this section.

Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
registered for the current year.

Special license plates shall be renewed each year by Service 8 9 Oklahoma or a licensed operator, unless authorized by Service 10 Oklahoma to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year. 11 Service Oklahoma shall notify by mail all persons issued special 12 license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon 13 14 presentation to a licensed operator or Service Oklahoma. The 15 license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

16 On and after January 1, 2022, if a special license plate is 17 issued pursuant to this section, any registration fee required for 18 such plate pursuant to this section and the fee required pursuant to 19 Section 1132 of this title shall be remitted at the same time and 20 subject to a single registration period. Service Oklahoma shall 21 determine, by rule, a method for making required fee and 22 registration period adjustments if a special license plate is 23 obtained during a twelve-month period for which a registration fee 24 has already been remitted pursuant to Section 1132 of this title.

The combination of fees in a single remittance shall not alter the
 apportionment otherwise provided for in this section.

Service Oklahoma is hereby directed to develop and implement a 3 4 system whereby licensed operators are permitted to accept 5 applications for special license plates authorized under this section. The licensed operator shall confirm the applicant's 6 7 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 8 9 information directly into such system and generate a receipt 10 accordingly. For performance of these duties, licensed operators 11 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 12 registration of a motor vehicle. The licensed operator fees for 13 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the 14 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund. Beginning January 1, 15 2023, the licensed operator fees for acceptance of applications and 16 renewals shall be paid out of the Service Oklahoma Reimbursement 17 Fund.

18 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates 19 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1, 20 2006, Service Oklahoma shall discontinue issuance and renewal of 21 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special 22 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license 23 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration 24

1 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be 2 removed from the vehicle.

Except as otherwise provided in law, for special license plates 3 authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special license plates shall 4 5 be developed or issued by Service Oklahoma until Service Oklahoma receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications therefor. 6 The 7 prepaid applications must be received by Service Oklahoma within one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective date of the authorization 8 9 or the authority to issue shall be null and void. In the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are not received by Service 10 11 Oklahoma within such prescribed time period any payment so received 12 shall be refunded accordingly.

The license plates shall be designed in 11 consultation with the Masonic Fraternities of Oklahoma and shall contain the Masonic emblem; 12

5. Shriners Hospitals for Children License Plate - such plates shall be designed to demonstrate support for Shriners Hospitals for Children and shall be issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Shriners Temple in Oklahoma. The license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Shriners Temples in Oklahoma and shall contain the Shriners emblem;

Balloonists License Plate - such plates shall be designed
and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for hot air
ballooning in this state;

22 7. Order of the Eastern Star License Plate - such plates shall
23 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member
24 of an Order of the Eastern Star. Such persons may apply for an

Order of the Eastern Star license plate for each vehicle with a

Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an
application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate
authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate
shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star

8. Knights of Columbus License Plate - such plates shall be 8 9 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of 10 the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of 11 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying 12 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus 13 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights 14 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the 15 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation 16 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of 17 Columbus emblem:

9. Jaycees License Plate - such plates shall be designed and

On and after January 1, 2022, if a special license plate is 3 issued pursuant to this section, any registration fee required for 4 5 such plate pursuant to this section and the fee required pursuant to Section 1132 of this title shall be remitted at the same time and 6 7 subject to a single registration period. Service Oklahoma shall 8 determine, by rule, a method for making required fee and 9 registration period adjustments if a special license plate is 10 obtained during a twelve-month period for which a registration fee 11 has already been remitted pursuant to Section 1132 of this title. 12 The combination of fees in a single remittance shall not alter the 13 apportionment otherwise provided for in this section.

14 Service Oklahoma is hereby directed to develop and implement a 15 system whereby licensed operators are permitted to accept 16 applications for special license plates authorized under this 17 section. The licensed operator shall confirm the applicant's 18 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 19 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 20 information directly into such system and generate a receipt 21 accordingly. For performance of these duties, licensed operators 22 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 23 registration of a motor vehicle through June 30, 2025. Through June 24 30, 2025, the licensed operator fees for acceptance of applications

Any such authorized special 8 9 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration 10 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be 11 12 removed from the vehicle.

13 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, 14 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by Service 15 Oklahoma until Service Oklahoma receives one hundred prepaid 16 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by 17 Service Oklahoma within one hundred eighty (180) days of the 18 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall 19 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are 20 not received by Service Oklahoma within such prescribed time period 21 any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.
