As used in this section, "unauthorized camp" 17 means any tent, shelter, or bedding constructed or arranged for the 18 purpose of or in such a way to permit overnight use on a property 19 not designated as a campsite. 20 Persons may not use state-owned, county-owned, or municipal-21 owned lands for the purposes of establishing an unauthorized camp. 22 C. Any person who violates the provisions of this section 23 shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a

fine not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) or by imprisonment in the
