AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 587, is 14 amended to read as follows: 15 Section 587. The fee for such examinations shall be set by 16 rules promulgated by the Board of Examiners in Optometry, not to be 17 less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and not to exceed Two 18 Hundred Dollars (\$200.00), and a yearly license fee set by rules promulgated by the Board of Examiners in Optometry, not to exceed 19 Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), 20 21 shall be paid each fiscal year by all persons holding a license to 22 practice optometry in this state, and shall be paid not later than 23 the 30th day of June of each year. In the event of default of 24 payment of such license fee by any person, his or her certificate

1 shall be revoked by the Board of Examiners who shall take such action only after notifying the person in default by registered mail and allowing that person fifteen (15) days in which to comply with 3 this requirement. The Board shall be paid travel expenses as 5 provided in the State Travel Reimbursement Act, Section 500.1 et 6 seq. of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The secretary-treasurer 7 shall receive compensation fixed by the Board, not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) per month. All fees and charges collected 8 by the secretary-treasurer of the Board shall be paid on the first 10 day of each month into a revolving fund in the State Treasury to be 11 designated as the "Optometry Board Revolving Fund". This fund shall 12 consist of all monies received by the Board of Optometry other than 13 appropriated funds. The revolving fund shall be a continuing fund 14 not subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be under the 15 control and management of the Board of Optometry. Expenditures from 16 this fund shall be made pursuant to the purposes of Sections 581 17 through 606 of this title and without legislative approval. 18 Warrants for expenditures shall be drawn by the State Treasurer 19 based on claims signed by an authorized employee or employees of the 20 Board of Optometry and approved for payment by the Director of the 21 Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
