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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 5-118, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 5-118. <u>A.</u> Regular meetings of the board of education
17	of each school district shall be held upon the first Monday of each
18	month, or upon such day as may be fixed by the board. Special
19	meetings may be held from time to time as circumstances may demand.
20	B. All meetings of the boards of education shall be public
21	meetings, and in all such meetings the vote of each member must be
22	publicly cast and recorded. Executive sessions will be permitted
23	only for the purpose of discussing the employment, hiring,
24	appointment, promotion, demotion, disciplining, or resignations of

1 any or all of the employees or volunteers of the school district, 2 and for the purpose of discussing negotiations concerning employees and representatives of employee groups, and for the purpose of 3 4 hearing evidence and discussing the expulsion or suspension of a 5 student or students only when requested by the student involved or his or her parent, attorney, or legal guardian; provided, however, 6 7 that any vote or action thereon must be taken in a public meeting with the vote of each member publicly cast and recorded. It is 8 9 required that the board of education shall provide notice to the 10 student, his or her parent, attorney or legal guardian that said 11 student is entitled to an executive session regarding the discussion 12 of expulsion or suspension of said student.

13 <u>C.</u> Any action taken in violation of the provisions of this act 14 shall be invalid.

15 D. Each member of the board of education of a school district 16 with an average daily attendance exceeding fifteen thousand (15,000) 17 or a school district where boundaries encompass a total population 18 exceeding one hundred thousand (100,000) persons according to the 19 last preceding Federal Decennial Census may be paid from the 20 district's general fund a stipend of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) 21 for each regular, special or adjourned meeting of the board of 22 education that he or she attends, but not for more than four 23 meetings in any calendar month.
