NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7401-101 of Title 10, unless 15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 16 The foster care maintenance payment for resource parents who 17 are traditional foster parents shall be at least: 18 Twenty-two Dollars and seventy-two cents (\$22.72) per day, 19 or Six Hundred Eighty-one Dollars and sixty cents (\$681.60) per 20 month, for a child who is zero (0) years to five (5) years of age; 21 Twenty-five Dollars and forty-two cents (\$25.42) per day, or 22 Seven Hundred Sixty-two Dollars and sixty cents (\$762.60) per month, 23 for a child who is six (6) to twelve (12) years of age; and
