AMENDATORY 12 amended to read as follows: 13 Section 166.2. A. Effective July 1, 1993, there is hereby 14 created the Commission for Rehabilitation Services, an agency of the 15 State of Oklahoma, a body corporate and politic, with powers of 16 government and with the authority to exercise the rights, privileges 17 and functions as herein specified, with its lawful operations deemed 18 to be an essential governmental function of the State of Oklahoma 19 with all the attributes thereof. 20 The Commission shall appoint and remove the Director of the 21 Department of Rehabilitation Services, approve programs, policy and 22 budget, and perform the necessary functions of a governing board for 23 the State Department of Rehabilitation Services.

Τ	C. 1. The Commission shall consist of three (3) seven (7)
2	members, to be appointed by June 15, 1993 , as follows:
3	a. one member two members shall be appointed by the
4	President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate for
5	a three-year term,
6	b. one member two members shall be appointed by the
7	Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives for a
8	three-year term, and
9	c. one member three members shall be appointed by the
10	Governor for a three-year term .
11	2. Thereafter, beginning with the expiration of the terms of
12	the three members initially appointed, the Commission shall consist
13	of three (3) members, appointed as follows:
14	a. one member shall be appointed by the President Pro
15	Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate and shall serve a
16	term of one (1) year,
17	b. one member shall be appointed by the Speaker of the
18	Oklahoma House of Representatives and shall serve a
19	term of two (2) years, and
20	c. one member shall be appointed by the Governor and
21	shall serve a term of three (3) years Except as
22	otherwise provided by this subsection, members shall
23	be appointed for terms of three (3) years. Each term

1		shall begin on July 1 of the respective year and end	
2		on June 30 three (3) years later.

22	3. <u>5.</u> The	ereafter, at the expiration of the term, or termination	
23	of the member'	s service for any reason, the original appointing	

of the member's service for any reason, the original appointing

authority shall appoint a successor for a term of three (3) years, or for the remainder of an unexpired term.

- D. Members of the Commission shall be knowledgeable of and have concern for rehabilitation issues and disability issues; provided, that such requirement shall not exclude participation of lay persons as Commission members. All members shall be residents of the state and qualified electors at the time of their appointment. Before entering upon the duties of their office, members of the Commission shall take the Constitutional oath of office and the same shall be filed with the Secretary of State. A member of the Commission may be reappointed to succeed himself or herself. Commission members shall be reimbursed for travel expenses incurred in the performance of their duties as provided in the State Travel Reimbursement Act.
- E. The original appointing authority may remove any commissioner for misconduct, incompetency or neglect of duty, after giving such commissioner a written statement of charges, and opportunity for a hearing.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
