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15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 7-114, is
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 7-114. A. Each person appearing to vote shall announce
19 that person's name to the judge of the precinct and shall provide
20 proof of identity, whereupon the judge shall determine whether the
21 person's name is in the precinct registry. As used in this section,
22 "proof of identity" shall mean a document that satisfies all of the
23 following requirements:

1 1. The document shows the name of the person to whom the
2 document was issued, and the name substantially conforms to the name
3 in the precinct registry;

4 2. The document shows a photograph of the person to whom the
5 document was issued;

6 3. The document includes an expiration date, which is after the
7 date of the election in which the person is appearing to vote. The
8 provisions of this paragraph shall not apply to:

- 9 a. an identification card that is valid indefinitely, or
- 10 b. an identification card issued by a branch of the armed
11 services of the United States to a person who is a
12 member of such branch or is retired therefrom; ~~and~~

13 4. The document was issued by the United States, the State of
14 Oklahoma or the government of a federally recognized Indian tribe or
15 nation~~;~~;

16 5. Provided, for any election conducted prior to January 1,
17 2027, if the person presents a voter identification card issued by
18 the appropriate county election board, such card may serve as proof
19 of identity without meeting the requirements of paragraphs 2 and 3
20 of this subsection; and

21 6. Provided, for any election conducted after January 1, 2027,
22 each person appearing to vote as described in this subsection shall
23 present proof of identity that meets the requirements of paragraphs
24 1 through 4 of this subsection.

1 B. 1. No later than January 1, 2027, Service Oklahoma shall
2 develop and make available a photo identification card that meets
3 the requirements of subsection A of this section to serve as a proof
4 of identity for voters;

5 2. The photo identification card described in this subsection
6 shall be provided free of charge by Service Oklahoma to any
7 registered voter who presents a voter registration card described in
8 Section 4-113 of this title or another document showing proof of
9 voter registration. The voter shall affirm that he or she is a
10 registered voter and does not possess a document that meets the
11 requirements of paragraphs 1 through 4 of subsection A of this
12 section;

13 3. The Chief Executive Officer of Service Oklahoma shall
14 consult with the Secretary of the State Election Board to develop
15 and design the photo identification card;

16 4. Photo identification cards issued under this subsection
17 shall be valid for a period of ten (10) years;

18 5. Registered voters must apply for a new identification card
19 upon a change of name or residential address; and

20 6. Photo identification cards shall only be available at state-
21 run Service Oklahoma locations.

22 C. The requirements for proof of identity described in
23 subsection A of this section shall apply to each voter appearing to
24 vote at an in-person absentee voting site.

1 subparagraph shall not apply if the voter was not
2 required to provide a driver license number or the
3 last four digits of the voter's Social Security number
4 at the time of registration, and

5 e. the provisional ballot meets the eligibility
6 requirements set forth in Section 7-116.1 of this
7 title.

8 3. A voter casting a provisional ballot as provided in this
9 section who has legally changed his or her name, but has not updated
10 the name on the voter registry, may note this fact on the affidavit
11 and submit a form prescribed by the Secretary of the State Election
12 Board to update his or her name. In such a case, and where the
13 requirements of Section 4-117 of this title are satisfied, the
14 provisional ballot shall be deemed to meet the requirements of
15 subparagraph a of paragraph 2 of this subsection.

16 4. A voter casting a provisional ballot as provided in this
17 section who has changed his or her address of residence, but has not
18 updated the address on the voter registry, may note this fact on the
19 affidavit and submit a form to update the address prescribed by the
20 Secretary of the State Election Board. In such a case, and where
21 the requirements of Section 4-117 of this title are satisfied, the
22 provisional ballot shall be deemed to meet the requirements of
23 subparagraph a of paragraph 2 of this subsection.

1 5. False swearing or affirming under oath shall be punishable
2 as a felony as provided in Section 16-103 of this title, and the
3 penalty shall be distinctly set forth on the face of the statement.

4 E. The Secretary of the State Election Board and the Chief
5 Executive Officer of Service Oklahoma shall promulgate rules and
6 procedures to implement the requirements of this section.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.

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
