Supp. 2024, Section 1698.412), which relates to the CDR Ernest Evans, First Tribal Recipient of the Medal of Honor, Memorial Trail; modifying name of memorial highway; amending Section 3, Chapter 352, O.S.L. 2023 (69 O.S. Supp. 2024, Section 1698.429), which relates to The Honorable Leonard Earl Sullivan Memorial Bridge; modifying location of marker placement; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.479 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The section of State Highway 5 west of Temple beginning at the intersection of N2620 road extending east to the intersection of N2640 road in Cotton County shall be designated as the "Will Hardin Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.480 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
